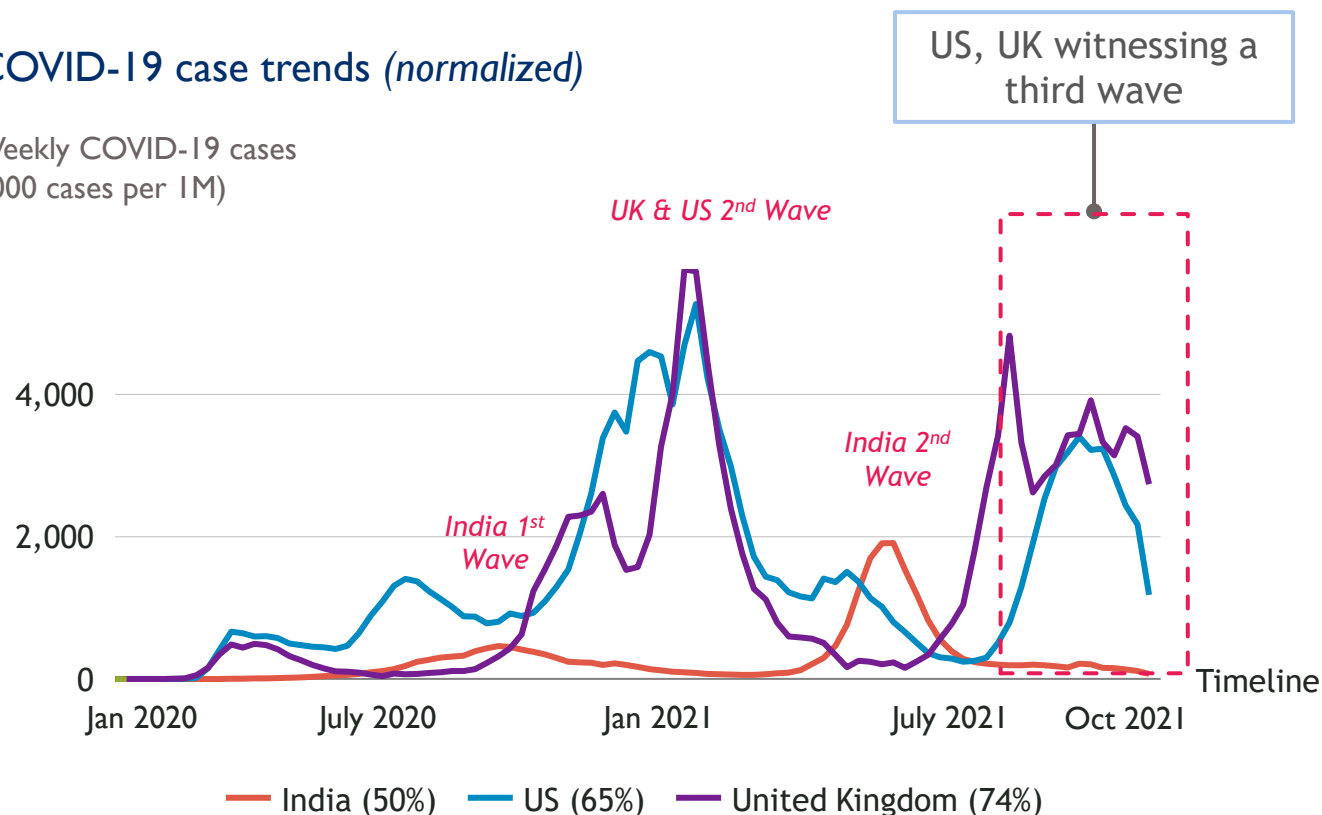

... Turbo-driving vaccination is key to build resilience with support of private sector



~36% rural popln. vaccinated (vs ~64% & 46% for large and small towns respectively)



Vx effectiveness in preventing mortality^{1,2} post 1st dose-96%; preventing death post 2nd dose-97%








Vaccination, like routine immunization is predominantly being driven by govt. (90%+)



Private sector engagement critical to bridge gaps to support ongoing Vx, boosters & RI

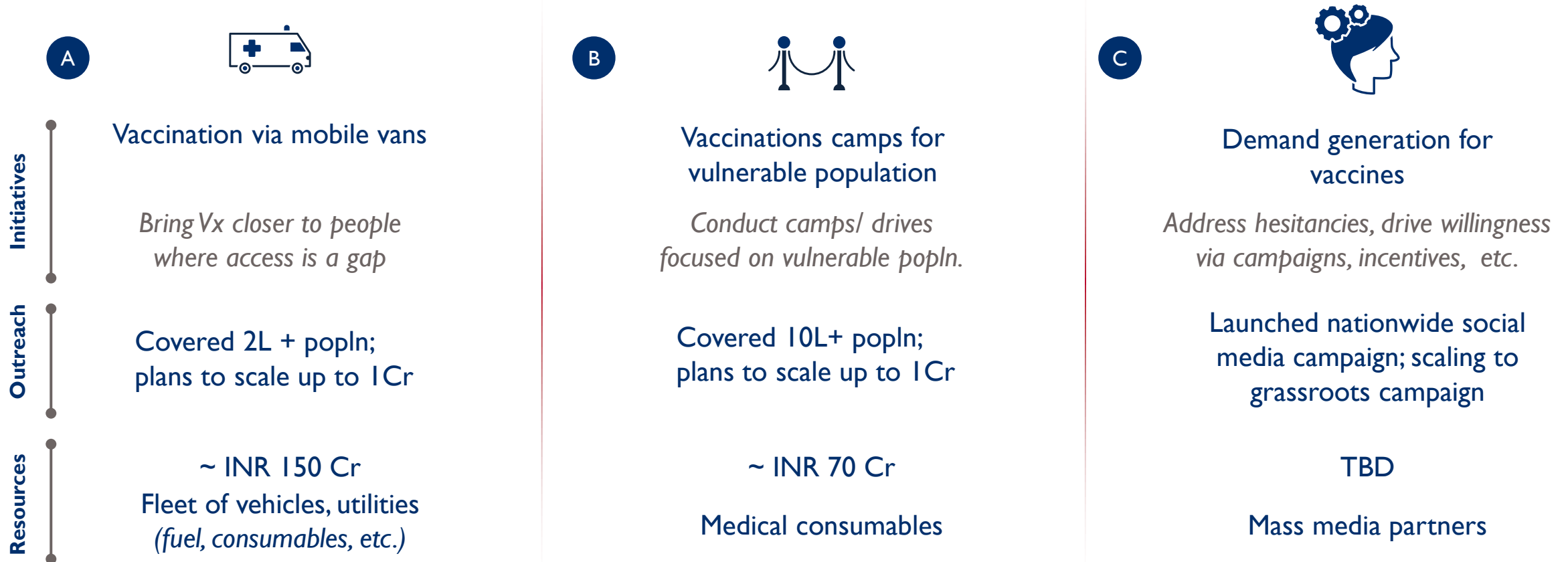
